## **Resignation of CFO**

**Melbourne, 3 July 2017:** Integral Diagnostics Limited (**ASX: IDX**) announces that Chief Financial Officer, Mr Craig Bremner has tendered his resignation from the Company, taking effect 31 August 2017.

Craig joined the Company in 2005 and was instrumental in supporting the Company through a successful IPO in October 2015.

The Board and Mr Bremner have mutually agreed to reduce the six month notice period required at the end of Craig's minimum employment term to two months.

Ms Anne Lockwood, IDX's Financial Controller, has agreed to assume the Chief Financial Officer role in an interim capacity, from 1 September 2017. Anne is a Chartered Accountant by training. She is currently a member of IDX's Senior Management Group, and is a former partner of a major accounting firm, with extensive experience across audit, technical accounting and mergers and acquisitions within the listed company environment.

IDX will continue with its recruitment process to find a permanent appointee for Chief Financial Officer.
